Donna Pickens is an artist and art educator, with more than 30 years of experience teaching art (kindergarten through adult classes) in a variety of public and private settings.

After living in Atlanta for 33 years, Donna moved to Montgomery, Alabama in 2004, working as Assistant Curator of Education at the Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts for the next 12 years. In her role at the Museum, she developed art programs, classes, and tours for children and adults, including the art curriculum and lessons for the annual fifth grade Montgomery public school tours and the arts integrated curriculum for the weekly Artist in Residence Program at the Wares Ferry Road Elementary School. She is currently working as a Special Projects Coordinator with the Alabama Arts Alliance.

As a professional artist, Donna created numerous large-scale public and private art commissions in Atlanta, and her work has been shown in local, regional, national, and international juried exhibitions.

Donna's professional training includes a B.A. from the University of Texas, an M.A. from Stanford University, and an M.F.A. from Georgia State University.
